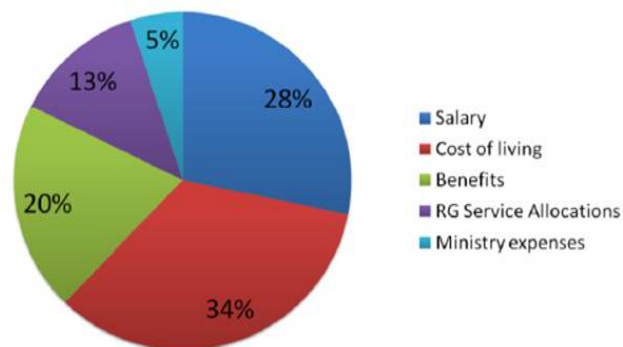


FAQ's about our Support

- **How much do you have to raise total?**
*(\$8853 per month X 12 months = \$106,236) for our On-going Support
 + (\$50,000) for our Missionary Start-Up Fund
 = \$156,236 = TOTAL*
- **What does that pay for?**
On-going covers salary, benefits, social security, taxes, ministry budget, etc.

How does the monthly support get allocated?



Start-Up covers all training, tools and ministry preparation needs

All One-Time gifts will be applied to our "One-Time Start Up" Costs - \$50,000

- Travel to the Field
- Shipping (Personal Items, Furniture, etc.)
- Vehicle Funds
- Relocation Funds
- Pre-Field Training & Conference
- Computer
- Language Up-Front Costs
- Rental Security / Deposit Costs
- Minimum Balance in Funds Account



- Do you have to raise it all before you can leave for the field?
Yes. We don't have to have it all by the time we leave but we do need to know it has been pledged and much of it has started to already be given.
- If you don't go to the field, what happens to the money that was given?
The Director of the region that we intended to go to would decide. If it would happen the support would likely go to benefit the needs of that region but there is not a hard rule on this and we don't expect it to happen. (:

- Why do you have to raise so much money to be a missionary?
Based on their experience, the agency decides on how much they think we need to be successful and sustain a long effective career in ministry. We have to raise support for many things that typical employers often help to cover for their employees. We will not have too much or too little with this amount.
- What's the difference between the "Salary" & the "Cost of Living Allowance"?
The Salary is the same amount given to all ReachGlobal missionaries with our status. The Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) is the amount that fluctuates based on the cost of living in the area of the world that each missionary is going to live and serve in.
- Which is better for me to give to: the Start-Up Fund or the On-Going Fund?
You should give as you feel led because both are important. To us, the On-going fund is probably more critical since those supporters help carry us into the mission field for years to come; yet we can't get there without Start-Up.
- Can I give all my money for the year at once or do I have give it monthly?
Any way that you want to give us fine. If you give it all at once, the agency will just average it out over the year.
- When should I start giving, now or when you leave?
Any time you are ready, you can start sending in your support. We need 100% of our funds pledged to be able to leave. We do not need all of the funds in hand before we leave.
- Is it ok to just pledge right now and start giving when you leave?
Yes. You can complete a pledge card or the online form at our "Support Us" page and that will suffice until we leave for the field. We can include that pledged figure in our percentages.
- Will I get a receipt for my tax records when I give?
Yes. ReachGlobal will respond to your gift by sending you a mailing with a receipt.
- How will I know when you get my gift?
It will take a few days or more to process your gift and then after it is reflected in our Ministry Account (Fowler-#1664) we will connect with you.
- Do I have to donate through ReachGlobal? Can't I just give it to you?
Personal gifts are acceptable, but it is best to give your gift through ReachGlobal because they can give a tax receipt and we cannot. They also need to see the support begin to build up in our Ministry account.
